Crash Data Mapping from Legacy System to Cobalt Crash Data System

MPD in August of 2015 has moved to a different application which is COBALT RMS system which comprises of both crime and traffic crash applications. In this process there were many schema level changes applied in the new database to store the traffic crashes which were more compliant to MMUCC IV edition than the prior application. The old crash data which is residing separately has its own schema definitions which are different from the new database. MPD has performed a data migration from the old legacy database to the new database but largely the assets and attributes migrated were generally unsuccessful.
