4.2 The Contractor agrees to perform up to the point at which the total amount payable by the District does not exceed the total amount currently obligated to the task order in section 4.1. The Contractor is not authorized to continue work beyond that point. The District will not be obligated in any event to reimburse the Contractor in excess of the amount obligated to the task order.

4.3 The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer and Contract Administrator in writing at least sixty days prior to the date when, in the Contractor's best judgment, the work will reach the point at which the total amount payable by the District will approximate 75 percent of the total amount then allotted to the task order for performance.

The notification will state (1) the estimated date when the point will be reached and (2) an estimate of additional funding, if any,needed to continue performance through the end of the period specified on page 1.
