

The following questions were submitted by participant and are provided below with their responses, please respond to the solicitation accordingly.

- Pg 4. 6.1.2 Key Personnel . ***Does licensed Traffic Engineer (in the sentence below) imply PTOE or PE?***
A Planner (AICP) or Licensed Traffic Engineer with at least four (4) years of experience specifically in conceptualizing and designing urban road diets or other geometric interventions that prioritize safety for pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit users.
 - ***Response: This means PE***

- Pg 9. 8.1.1.1 Resumes should be no more than 10 pages. ***Please confirm that a specific resume can be over 1 page.***
 - ***Response: This means that the total page count for all staff resumes should not exceed 10 pages. Contractors may choose how to best use the pages within the limit.***

- Pg 9. 8.1.1.2 Include no more than ten (10) past projects. ***Please confirm that a specific project sheets can exceed 1 page (as long as the overall page limit is adhered to). Please confirm that graphics are allowed in the SF 330 project sheets.***
 - ***Response: Confirmed, projects may exceed one page as long as the total overall page limit is adhered to. Graphics are allowed but shall be included in the page count.***

- Pg 10. Section 9. Past performance with project references on contracts with Government agencies and private industry in terms of quality of work, cost control, and compliance with performance schedules. ***Can you please provide guidance on how past performance will be evaluated and what kind of documentation you want to see in the proposal? Is a list of references sufficient? What else might the evaluation committee be willing to consider for this factor?***
 - ***Response: The committee will consider past performance by any provided statements from references on specific completed projects submitted as references. The committee would like to know the contractor's performance in terms of quality of work, timeliness, responsiveness, and adherence to and best use of the budget.***

- ***Do the signed amendments need to be part of the submission? If so, do they count towards the page limit?***
 - ***Response: All signed Amendments need to be part of your submission and will not count toward the page limit.***
