Section 23.0 As-Built Drawings and Specifications states, "Upon completion of construction, Consultant shall complete the DOEE's 'As-Built Certification by Professional Engineer' form on the 'Stormwater Management Compliance Datasheet' and electronically sign . Please clarify if the Department's intent is for the CM to maintain a red-lined set of drawings (not signed and sealed) and for the Contractor to provide the official signed and sealed record set of as-built drawings and seal the as-built drawings and provide the Project Manager with electronic pdf file, certified and marked DOEE's as-built drawings, as applicable." The responsibilities as related to as-built drawings and specifications are unclear in the Contract Documents and consultant RFQ. The construction contract requires that the signed and sealed As-Built Record Drawings be provided by the Contractor. The construction contract also provides a method of payment for this work - bid item 108-006 Record Drawings and As-Built Drawings. With regards to the DOEE requirement for as-built drawings, the "As-Built Certification by Professional Engineer" form is typically included in the contract drawings for DDOT construction projects and is typically required to be signed and sealed by the Contractor's professional engineer, not CM Staff. However, Contract plan sheet SW-10 does not include the form. The Contractor is the only party to the Contract who has the resources (on-demand survey) to verify as-built conditions and document all known changes performed in the field. Verification of as-built information by the CM Team would require significant additional survey resources for the CM Team (and cost to the Department) and presents professional liability concerns, as the CM is not the party responsible for the built condition.	CM is not required to complete the DOEE's as built certification. The EOR will do the certification. CM is required to do all the inspection in the field and have DOEE's inspectors signed off the all the water quality work. CM also is required to have redlined set in the field office and mark all the changes and to QA/QC the contractor's prepared as built drawing for the whole job. It is contractor's responsibility to prepare the as built per standard specification.
