The Construction Inspectors shall, at the time of the submission, meet one of the following qualification requirements: - Be National Institute for Certification in Engineering Technologies				

(NICET) certified as a Transportation Engineering Technician Construction, Level II or higher, with a minimum of two (2) years of bridge/highway construction experience acceptable to the DDOT team leader. - Be certified through combination of the following agencies as relevant to the project with a minimum of five (5) years full time experience, acceptable to the DDOT team leader, as a construction engineer or inspector on bridge/highway construction projects: a. Mid-Atlantic Region Technician Certification Program (MARTCP) for concrete field and asphalt field. b. The American Concrete Institute (ACI) for concrete sampling, inspection, and testing. c. WACEL (Washington Area Council of Engineering Laboratories) for structural steel inspection, soil and concrete sampling, inspection, and testing. d. Virginia DOT (VDOT) certification for concrete, soil, asphalt, and pavement marking.
