Re: Safety Improvements on Naylor Road between Minnesota Avenue and 25th Street SE

Dear Commissioner White:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- **Safety Improvements on Naylor Road between Minnesota Avenue and 25th Street SE**

The purpose of this project is to upgrade signs and markings on Naylor Road SE between Minnesota Avenue and 25th Street SE with the aim of slowing traffic speeds and increasing visibility at intersections. A concept drawing of the proposed changes is attached in **Appendix A**. Features of the project include:

- Curb extensions constructed with bollards and striping
- Standard DDOT parking restrictions, supplemented with striping, at intersections to improve pedestrian visibility
- A consistent parking lane on the west side of the street from Q to 25th Streets SE.
- A double yellow centerline and parking boxes
- New Speed Limit signs.

The proposed improvements will result in removal of approximately seven (7) parking spaces between Q St and 23rd St, while adding approximately twelve (12) parking spaces between R St and 25th St. The overall parking changes include five (5) additional parking spaces and a consistent full-time parking lane on the west curbs of Naylor Road SE within the project area.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing by (thirty days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Project Delivery Administration at 250 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003. DDOT will review and evaluate comments and anticipates initiating implementation of the above-mentioned modifications starting at the end of the thirty business days, pending weather conditions.

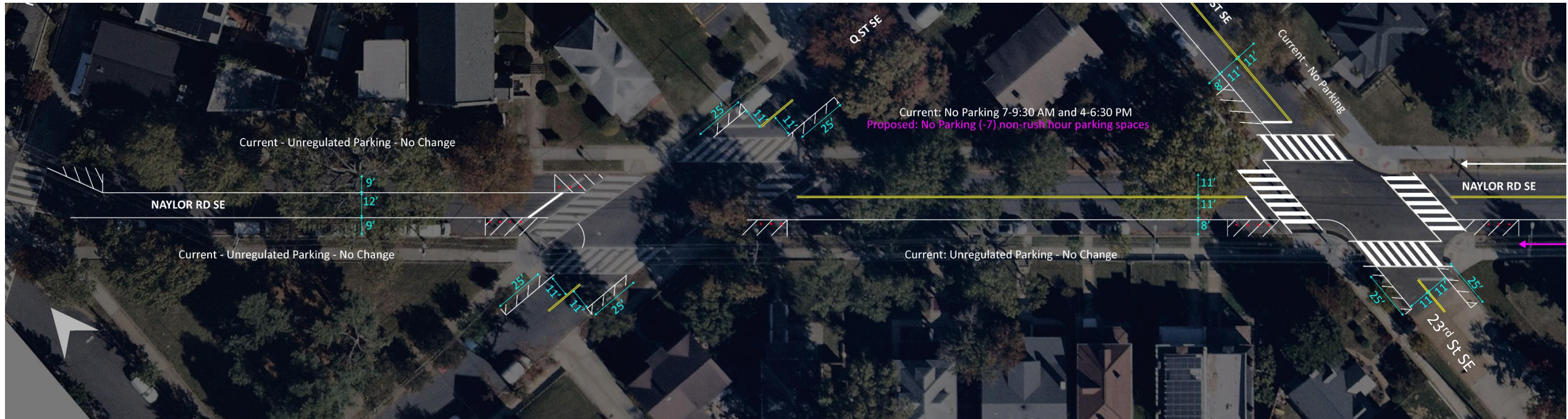
