Dear Chairperson Thomas:

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" DC LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction.

After careful evaluation of parking impacts to residential blocks in Advisory Neighborhood Commission 5E, DDOT intends to install Residential Permit Parking (RPP) signage on the east and west side of the 200 block of Seaton Place, N.E. (subject to adjustment based on adjacent land-use).

• The signs will restrict parking between Monday – Friday 7:00 am – 8:30 pm.
