Re: Bus Stop Relocation and Curbside Redesignations to 5th, 6th and K Street NW

Dear Chairpersons Eichler and Shankle,

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

To improve bus service in the District, DDOT and WMATA intend to relocate two bus stops from 5th Street NW and one from K Street NW to 6th St NW.

DETAILED PROPOSED ACTIONS

DDOT and WMATA periodically review bus stops, bus routes, and other elements of the transit system to determine what to improve operational efficiency. To improve service on Metrobus route 74 DDOT and WMATA staff determined the need to move the route 74 layover location at K Street NW and 6th Street NW to 6th Street NW at Massachusetts Avenue NW. This move improves bike safety and ADA access by moving the bus layover space away from the protected bicycle lanes on K Street NW.

Additionally, to improve bus operations WMATA and DDOT staff determined that the P6 bus route should be moved from 5th Street NW to 6th Street NW. To support this change, two new stops will be created on 6th Street NW at I Street NW and the existing stops on 5th Street NW will be removed (see Visual Aid).

The existing bus stops will be given new curbside designations. The existing NB stop on 5th and I Street NW will be converted to No Standing/No Parking Anytime and the stop on 5th and K St NW will become a new 45

ft commercial loading zone in operation from 7am – 6:30pm, Mon - Fri. The SB stop on 5th and K St NW will remain as the existing commercial loading zone designation. The existing layover on K St NW and 6th St NW will be converted to a 40ft 'No Parking Zone' for the building entrance, and metered parking.
