Re: Reduction of speed limit on North Capitol Street/Blair Road NW from Harewood Road NE/NW to Van Buren Street NW from 30 mph to 25 mph

Dear Chairpersons Brooks, Bowser, and Edwards,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- **Reduction of the speed limit on North Capitol Street/Blair Road NW from Harewood Road NE/NW to Van Buren Street NW from 30 mph to 25 mph**

At the conclusion of the engineering study, DDOT determined that the speed limit on *North Capitol Street/Blair Road from Harewood Road NE/NW to Van Buren Street NW* will be posted at 25 mph, which is a reduction from the existing posted limit of 30 mph.

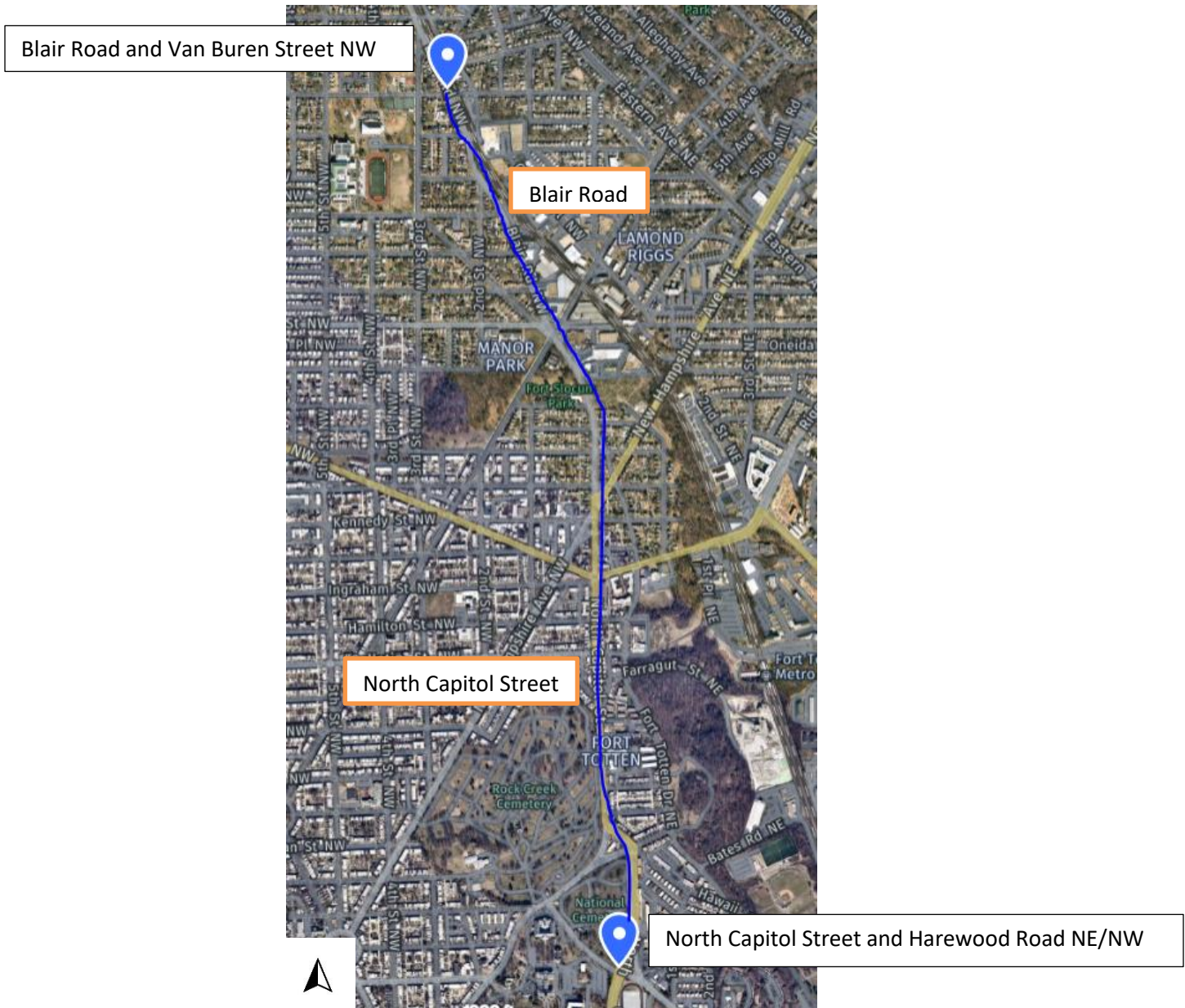


Figure 1: Location of Proposed Speed Limit Change from 30 mph to 25 mph

Figure 1 shows the location of the proposed speed limit change.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing by Friday, July 15, 2022 (thirty days after the date of this notice) with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT). Project Delivery Administration anticipates initiating implementation of the above-mentioned modifications starting at the end of the thirty business days, pending weather conditions.
