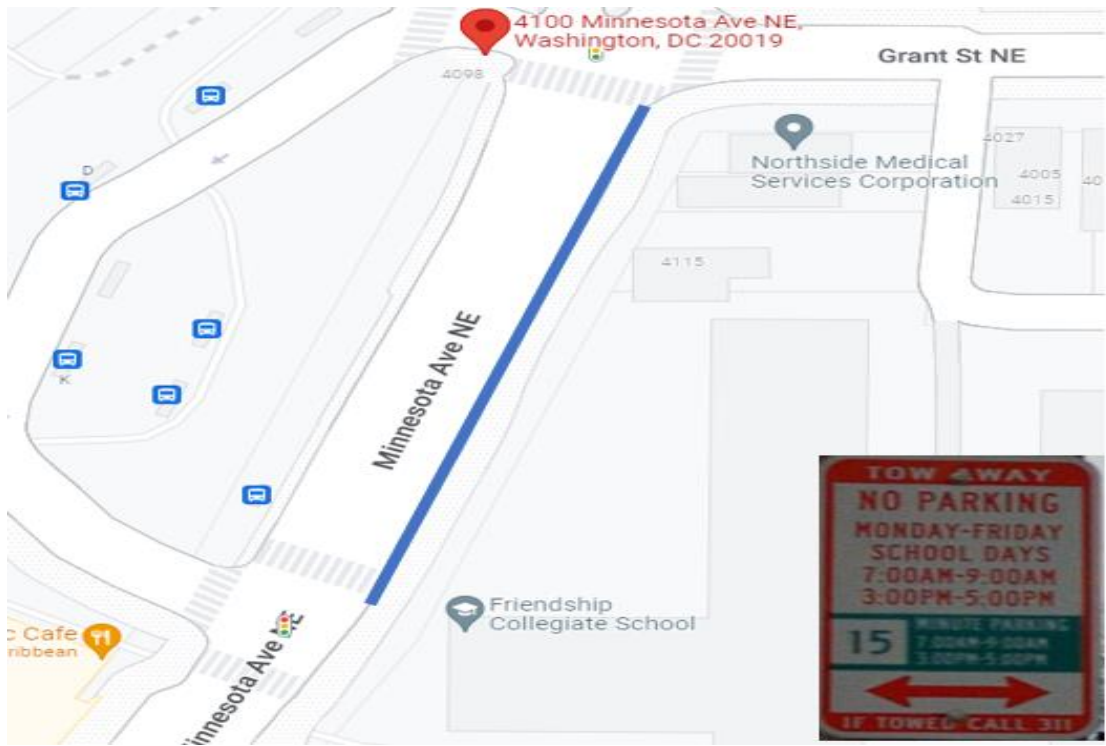
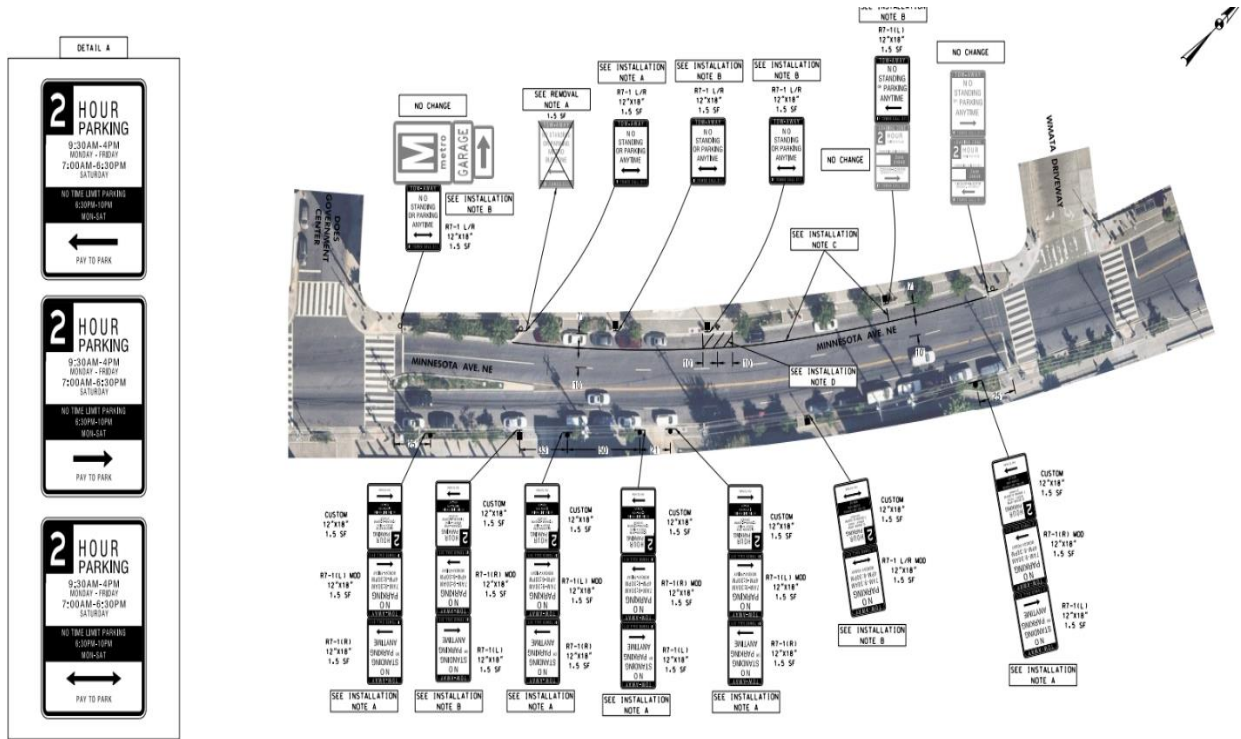
Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

DDOT will reconfigure the unrestricted parking to install No Standing or Parking Anytime restrictions on the west side of the 4000 block of Minnesota Ave, NE, and rush-hour restricted parking on the east side of the 4000 block of Minnesota Ave, NE as indicated in the visual below. The current commercial loading zone on the southbound lanes of Minnesota Avenue will remain. Additionally, a School Loading Zone will be installed in the layby on the northbound lanes of the 4100 block of Minnesota Ave NE with the following restrictions:

1. No Standing or Parking Anytime restrictions on the west side of the 4000 block of Minnesota Ave NE starting at American Job center heading north up to current commercial loading zone.
2. 2-hour paid parking with rush hour restrictions (7AM-9:30AM / 4PM-6:30PM) on the east side of the 4000 block of Minnesota Ave NE starting at Sharks Plaza heading north up to Friendship Collegiate Academy Campus.
3. No Parking School Days 7am-5pm, Monday through Friday on the east side of the 4000 Block of Minnesota Ave NE starting at Friendship Collegiate Academy Campus to Grant Street NE.
4. 15-minute parking (Drop off and pick up) from 7am-9am and 3pm to 5pm School Days on the east side of the 4000 Block of Minnesota Ave NE starting at Friendship Collegiate Academy Campus to Grant Street NE.

Currently all parking is unrestricted.
