Re: Yuma Street, S.E., between Condon Terrace and 8th Street Corridor Improvements

#### **Dear Chairperson Cummings**

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCMR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- Remove existing speed table on Yuma Street, S.E. in front of Ferebee-Hope Recreation
   Center
- Install raised crosswalk on Yuma Street, S.E. in front of Ferebee-Hope Recreation Center,
   48' east of existing speed table
- Install Full Time Parking Restriction 25' from proposed Raised Crosswalk in each direction, removing approximately 8 parking spots
- Install Speed Table on Yuma Street, S.E., east of Condon Terrace.
- Install Speed Limit signs of 20 MPH at each end of Yuma Street, S.E. between Condon Terrace and 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

Based on safety concerns expressed by the community and field investigation, DDOT intends to implement the above recommendation to improve accessibility to the Ferebee-Hope Recreate Center and to enhance traffic safety of all roadway users.

**Figures 1-3** illustrates proposed improvements to be installed or removed along Yuma Street, S.E. between Condon Terrace and 8<sup>th</sup> Street.




Figure 2: Proposed Improvements along Yuma Street, S.E. at Ferebee Hope Recreation Center

DDOT will review and evaluate comments and anticipates initiating implementation of the above-mentioned modifications starting at the end of the thirty business days, pending weather conditions.
