**Re: Traffic Signal Installation at the Intersection of Eastern Avenue and Sligo Mill Road, NE
NOI 22-235-TESD**

Dear Chairperson:

Pursuant to the “Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000” D. C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 349) April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following modifications in your jurisdiction.

- ***Eastern Avenue and Sligo Mill Road, NE Intersection Traffic Signal Installation***

An independent determination has been made by the DDOT/Traffic Engineering and Safety Division to install and operate a traffic signal at the intersection of Eastern Avenue and Sligo Mill Road, NE. Traffic signal control can provide for the safe and efficient movement of vehicular, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic operating through and in the immediate vicinity of this intersection. The proposed new traffic signal will be timed to operate in harmony with adjacent traffic signals on the Eastern Avenue corridor to minimize disruptions to through traffic.

The proposed improvements also include the reconstruction of ADA ramps, closure of the slip lane from Sligo Mill Road to southbound Eastern Avenue, reconfiguration of streetlights for improved nighttime visibility, installation of accessible pedestrian signals, and restriping of all crosswalks bringing them to current ADA standards.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing or emailed by Tuesday, October 12, 2022 (Thirty business days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), Traffic Engineering and Safety Division at 250 M Street, SE, Washington, D.C. 20003.
