Re: 3rd St NW & Shepherd St NW Safety Project

Dear Chairperson Livingston,

Pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Amendment Act of 2000" D.C. LAW 13-249 (48 DCR 3491 April 20, 2001), the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is required to give a written notice of our intent (NOI) to modify traffic and/or parking requirements. This letter is being forwarded to you for the purpose of notification and solicitation of comments on our intent to implement the following in your jurisdiction:

DDOT proposes to close 3rd St NW between Shepherd St NW and Rock Creek Church Rd NW to vehicular traffic. In addition to the closure of 3rd St NW, several other changes to the adjacent intersections are proposed as part of the roadway closure plan to improve traffic safety.

- Signing and pavement marking updates to move parking setbacks 25' from the existing crosswalks to meet proper sight distance.
- Installation of a Stop controlled intersection for the eastbound approach at Shepherd St NW and Rock Creek Church Rd NW.
- Installation of a Stop controlled intersection for the southbound approach of 3rd St NW at Shepherd St NW.
- Removal of the stop control for the westbound approach of Shepherd St NW and 3rd St NW.

The purpose of the project is to improve safety by closing the redundant leg of the intersection which operates as a high-speed slip lane onto Rock Creek Church Rd NW. We are issuing this NOI at the 65% design stage to best incorporate public feedback and comments through the ongoing development stages of this project.

All comments on this subject matter must be filed in writing by July 26, 2023 (thirty business days after the date of this notice), with the District Department of Transportation, Transportation Operations Administration, 250 M Street, S.E. PAVEMENT MARKING GENERAL NOTES

- 1. ALL CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS AND PROCEDURES SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR HIGHWAYS AND STRUCTURES DATED 2013, ISSUED BY THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, EXCEPT AS AMENDED BY THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ADEQUATE PRECAUTION TO PROTECT ALL WALKS, GRADING, SIDEWALKS, AND FEATURES OUTSIDE THE LIMITS OF WORK, AND SHALL REPAIR AND REPLACE, OR OTHERWISE MAKE GOOD, AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER ANY SUCH OR OTHER DAMAGE SO CAUSED.
- 3. ALL STRIPING AND SIGN WORK SHALL MEET ALL APPLICABLE DDOT STANDARDS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND 2009 MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (MUTCD) REQUIREMENTS.
- 4. ALL PAVEMENT MARKINGS ARE THERMOPLASTIC UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LAYOUT THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT MARKING CROSS-SECTIONS IN THE FIELD AND CONFIRM DIMENSIONS BEFORE APPLYING THE FINAL MARKINGS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER IMMEDIATELY OF ANY DISCREPANCIES OR CHANGES TO PROPOSED LANE WIDTHS.
- 6. ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS MAY NOT BE SHOWN. ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS THAT CONFLICT WITH PROPOSED PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE ERADICATED BY A METHOD APPROVED BY DDOT.
- 7. FIELD VERIFY DRIVEWAY LOCATIONS BEFORE APPLYING STRIPING.









PROPOSED SIGNING GENERAL NOTES

- 1. ALL SIGNS SHALL BE HIGH INTENSITY SHEETING MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS OF AASHTO M268.
- 2. PROPOSED SIGNS SHALL BE INSTALLED SO THAT NO PORTION OF THE SIGN PANEL OVERHANGS ADJACENT ROADWAY PAVEMENT, I.E. SHALL NOT HANG IN FRONT OF A FACE OF CURB.
- 3. PROPOSED SIGN POSTS SHALL BE LOCATED A MINIMUM OF 2 FEET BEHIND ANY ADJACENT FACE OF CURB. IF LOCATED IN OR ADJACENT TO SIDEWALKS, A 32" MINIMUM CLEAR AND 48" PREFERRED PASSING SPACE ON EXISTING AND PROPOSED SIDEWALKS SHALL BE MAINTAINED.
- 4. PROPOSED SIGNS AT NEW LOCATIONS SHALL BE INSTALLED SO THEY DO NOT BLOCK THE VISIBILITY OF ANY EXISTING SIGNS OR SIGNALS.
- 5. FOR NEW POST INSTALLATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THAT THERE ARE NO CONFLICTING UNDERGROUND OR OVERHEAD UTILITIES.
- 6. SIGNS MOUNTED TO EXISTING LIGHT, SIGNAL, OR UTILITY POLES SHALL BE FASTENED WITH A MANUFACTURED STEEL BANDING SYSTEM. POLES SHALL NOT BE DRILLED DIRECTLY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT MANUFACTURER INFORMATION ON THE BANDING SYSTEM TO THE ENGINEER FOR APPROVAL PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

FLEXIBLE CHANNALIZER POST NOTES

- 1. CHANNELIZER POSTS SHALL BE SPACED 10 FEET ON CENTER AND OFFSET 6" FROM LANE LINES, AWAY FROM TRAVEL LANES.
- 2. CHANNELIZER POSTS SHALL BE INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS.
- 3. COLOR OF POST SHALL MATCH COLOR OF APPLICABLE EDGE LINE.
